



## Part 12 “A Fresh Anointing”

**Amos 8:11** "Behold, days are coming," declares the Lord GOD, "When I will send a famine on the land, Not a famine for bread or a thirst for water, But rather for hearing the words of the LORD."

### Revelation Chapter 3 Philadelphia and Laodicea

- **Philidelphia** is the restored church, a door only God could open, and ending in rapture
- **Laodicea** worldly, lukewarm, compromising, and the Lord was outside the church

### Message to Philadelphia

<sup>7</sup> "And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: He who is holy, who is true, who has the **key of David, who opens and no one will (can) shut**, and who shuts and no one opens, says this:

<sup>8</sup> 'I know your deeds. Behold, I have put before you an **open door** which no one can shut, because you have a little power, and have kept My word, and have not denied My name.

<sup>9</sup> Behold, I will cause *those* of the synagogue of Satan, who say that they are Jews and are not, but lie—I will make them come and bow down at your feet, and *make them* know that I have loved you. <sup>10</sup> Because you have kept the word of My perseverance, **I also will keep you from the hour of testing**, that *hour* which is about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth. <sup>11</sup> I am coming quickly; hold fast what you have, so that no one will take your crown. <sup>12</sup> He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name.

<sup>13</sup> He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

1 Corinthians 16:9 "because a great door (wide door) for effective work has opened to me, and there are many who oppose me." Referencing Acts 19

### Message to Laodicea

<sup>14</sup> “To the angel of the church in Laodicea write: The Amen, the faithful and true Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God, says this:

<sup>15</sup> “I know your deeds, that you are **neither cold nor hot** (wishy-washy, compromising); I wish that you were cold or hot. <sup>16</sup> So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit (vomit) you out of My mouth. <sup>17</sup> Because you say, “I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing,” and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked, <sup>18</sup> I advise you to buy from Me gold refined by fire so that you may become rich, and white garments so that you may clothe yourself, and *that* the shame of your nakedness will not be revealed; and eye salve to anoint your eyes so that you may see. <sup>19</sup> Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; therefore be zealous and repent. <sup>20</sup> **Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and will dine with him, and he with Me.** <sup>21</sup> He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. <sup>22</sup> He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.”

### David's Travels

- **Mizpah** (watchtower) has to do with the power of the **name of Jesus**
- **Judah** (praise) has to do with the power of **praise and worship**
  - **Hebrew words for praise:** 1. Yadah “extend hand, worship lifted hands” Ps 63:4, Shabach “Loud tone” Ps 35:27, Zamar “to touch-instrument” Ps 150, Barak “to kneel” Ps 71:14, Towdah “give thanks with extended hands” Ps 50:23, Halal “shine, boast, rave, celebrate, give light, given in marriage, clamorously foolish” Dancing is very common in Jewish weddings. Ps 149:3, 150:4 Under Halal you have words like: Ruah “to shout, leap, or celebrate; giyl “to whirl and spin about”, takah “clap as in crushing” to intimidate the enemy in battle.
  - **Hebrew words for worship:** Shachah “prostrate or bow down; Atsab “carve, fabricate, or fashion (arts), cegid “to worship.”
- **חֶרֶת Chereth** has to do with **suffering and seclusion** “forest” This was just south of Bethlehem his home town. Many times it feels we are coming full circle.

### A fresh anointing: wise virgins with extra oil

Matthew 25:1 “Then the kingdom of heaven will be comparable to ten virgins, who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. <sup>2</sup> Five of them were foolish, and five were prudent. <sup>3</sup> For when the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them, <sup>4</sup> but the prudent took oil in flasks along with their lamps. <sup>5</sup> Now while the bridegroom was delaying, they all got drowsy and *began* to sleep. <sup>6</sup> But at midnight there was a shout, ‘Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet *him*.’ <sup>7</sup> Then all those virgins rose and trimmed their lamps. <sup>8</sup> The foolish said to the prudent, ‘Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.’ <sup>9</sup> But the prudent answered, ‘No, there will not be enough for us and you *too*; go instead to the dealers and buy *some* for yourselves.’ <sup>10</sup> And while they were going away to make the purchase, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding feast; and the door was shut. <sup>11</sup> Later the other virgins also came, saying, ‘Lord, lord, open up for us.’ <sup>12</sup> But he answered, ‘Truly I say to you, I do not know you.’ <sup>13</sup> Be on the alert then, for you do not know the day nor the hour.”

Revelation 2:2 “I know your deeds and your toil and perseverance, and that you cannot tolerate evil men, and you put to the test those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them *to be* false; <sup>3</sup> and you have perseverance and have endured for My name’s sake, and have not grown weary. <sup>4</sup> But I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love (supreme love feast-communion). <sup>5</sup> Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first; or else I am coming to you and will remove your lampstand out of its place—unless you repent.”

Ephesians 5:25 “Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, <sup>26</sup> so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, <sup>27</sup> that He might present to Himself the **church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing**; but that she would be holy and blameless. <sup>28</sup> So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; <sup>29</sup> for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also *does* the church, <sup>30</sup> because we are members of His body. <sup>31</sup> FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND SHALL BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH. <sup>32</sup> This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church.

2 Corinthians 11:2 “For I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy; for I betrothed you to one husband, so that to Christ I might present you as a **pure virgin**.” Revelation 19:7 “Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and **his bride has made herself ready**.”

- The table of showbread precedes the lampstand
- Divine revelation
- We are being made ready as a bride for the bridegroom

## Lawlessness

2 Corinthians 6:14 “Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have **righteousness and lawlessness**, or what fellowship has light with darkness? <sup>15</sup> Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? <sup>16</sup> Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols?”

Matthew 7:21 “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven *will enter*. <sup>22</sup> Many will say to Me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?’ <sup>23</sup> And then I will declare to them, ‘**I never knew you**; DEPART FROM ME, **YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS**.’”

Hebrews 10:25 “not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.”

Hebrews 13:17 “Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they keep watch over your souls as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you.”

- It is challenging to really pastor in America today because of lawlessness
- Jezebel is marked with rebellion toward male authority
- The antichrist is called the lawless one
  - Tattoos and piercings
  - Alcohol and tobacco and ungodly partying
  - The lawlessness of the world getting into the church

Satan desires to replace true Biblical authority with a counterfeit authority. He seeks to replace true Holy Spirit revelation with counterfeit revelation and false prophet voices. He seeks to replace true teachers with false, and create a lawless environment.

### **Escaping Babylon**

Revelation 18:4 "Then I heard another voice from heaven say: "'Come out of her, my people,' so that you will not share in her sins, so that you will not receive any of her plagues."

2 Corinthians 6:16 "For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, 'I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM; AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE.

<sup>17</sup> "Therefore, COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE SEPARATE," says the Lord. "AND DO NOT TOUCH WHAT IS UNCLEAN; And I will welcome you. <sup>18</sup> "And I will be a father to you, And you shall be sons and daughters to Me," Says the Lord Almighty."
