



### **Part 3 “Judging and Reaping”**

Matthew 24:12 “Because lawlessness is increased, most people’s love will grow cold. <sup>13</sup> But the one who endures to the end, he will be saved.”

Proverbs 18:14 “The spirit of a man can endure his sickness, But *as for* a broken spirit who can bear it?”

#### **A spirit of Rejection**

- Unwanted pregnancies
- Fundamentally wanting to change kids into something they are not
- Taking out on kids frustrations
- Withholding love and affection

#### **Children View God a certain way because of Parents**

- They may have an aversion toward God
- The pain that comes from divorce
- The deep pain of favoritism
- A spirit of death/destruction can enter through wounds of rejection
- The spirit of fear

#### **Betrayal and Shame**

- After being betrayed walls are put up to not get hurt again
- Once betrayed or rejected you may feel a sense of shame
- Sometimes someone feels they will never amount to anything
- Public humiliation and malicious gossip

#### **Inability to Show Love**

- After being damaged and broken, people deal with anger and abusive behavior
- Deep down they have a desire to die and are never really happy

### **Destructive cycles examples: Begins with Rejection**

- rejection, unforgiveness, hatred, rebellion, suicide
- rejection, unforgiveness, depression, lusts, substance abuse
- rejection, unforgiveness, partying, sleeping around, and/or criminal behavior

Where hurt and rebellion exists, many times witchcraft will find a way in

### **Judging and Reaping**

- Sowing and reaping in judging parents
- If we have judged or sown evil, we need to deal with it scripturally

### **The Cross is the Remedy**

- Forgiving others
- Confess and repent of your part you played
- Open up to the Lord and ask for healing
- The divine exchange
- The blood and cross in between any sowing and reaping
- Deliverance connected to healing
- Receive it by faith, and stay in faith
