A Fresh Move of God Today

Matthew 13:52 "He said to them, Therefore every teacher (scribe) *and* interpreter of the Sacred Writings who has been instructed about *and* trained for the kingdom of heaven and has become a disciple is like a householder who brings forth out of his storehouse treasure that is new and [treasure that is] old [the fresh as well as the familiar]."

End Time Restoration

1. Jesus being the center, the standard, and the head of the church

John 16:13 “I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* at the present time. ¹³ But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify Me, for He will take from Mine and will disclose *it* to you.”

The Holy Spirit will have to help the church see and acknowledge Jesus for who he really is. He has never changed. He is still the savior from sin, the healer, the deliverer from demonic activity, the baptizer into the Holy Spirit, and the head over the church. We need the Holy Spirit to help us see him for who he really is, and to rally under his Lordship as the standard.

In ancient armies, the standard bearer was a key person. Every group of soldiers was trained to identify, acknowledge and respect its own particular standard, which may have been an eagle, leopard, or flag design of some sort. If at any time that group of soldiers was being overrun by the enemy or in danger of defeat, its commander would order the standard to be raised so as to be seen from all directions, and as they were trained, they would all rally to the standard and regroup. Our ultimate loyalty is to Jesus not a certain people group.

2. Delivered from satanic oppression

Warfare will be severe, as we seen in Joel 2. The locust were devouring and destroying. The vine has dried up, the fig tree withered, and joy has faded away. The oppression was severe. God called his people to a corporate fast. This caused the satanic forces to be driven away, and restoration to come. This satanic oppression has come in because of the disobedience, sin, and rebellion of the church world, and they are not truly looking to Christ as the standard.

Obadiah 1:17 presents the order of restoration. “But Mt Zion there shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; the house of Jacob shall possess their possessions.” First we must be a holy people. Acts 26:18 shows “that they may receive an inheritance among those who are sanctified [made holy] by faith in me.” God’s standards of holiness have never changed.

3. Restoration and Re-Equipping

Acts 1:8 “But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses.” Acts 2:17 “‘AND IT SHALL BE IN THE LAST DAYS,’ God says, ‘THAT I WILL POUR OUT MY SPIRIT ON ALL MANKIND; AND YOUR SONS AND YOUR DAUGHTERS WILL PROPHECY, AND YOUR YOUNG MEN

WILL SEE VISIONS, AND YOUR OLD MEN WILL HAVE DREAMS; ¹⁸ AND EVEN ON MY MALE AND FEMALE SERVANTS I WILL POUR OUT MY SPIRIT IN THOSE DAYS, And they will prophesy.” Isaiah 58/Joel 2 restoration

We see here the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, the restoration, and the empowering of the church. You don’t send a reaper into the harvest field without a sickle. We have to be equipped.

4. Re-Gathering into a great Army

Ezekiel 37 shows the valley of dry bones that became a great army when God breathed on them. Each member is properly joined together (the hand, eye, etc-1Cor 12:12; 14-15; 21).

Isaiah 60:1 "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you. See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the LORD rises upon you and his glory appears over you. **Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn.**"

Malachi 4:1 "For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every evildoer will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze," says the LORD of armies, "so that it will leave them neither root nor branches. ² But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and frolic like calves from the stall. ³ And you will crush the wicked underfoot, for they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day that I am preparing," says the LORD of armies." The God of peace shall crush satan under your feet.
