Binding the Strongman and destroying his works

Mark 3:22 “the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, “He is possessed by Beelzebub, and by the ruler of the demons He casts out demons.” ²³ So He called them to Him and said to them in parables, “How can Satan cast out Satan? ²⁴ If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. ²⁵ If a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand. ²⁶ And if Satan rises up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but is coming to an end. ²⁷ No one can enter a strong man’s house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man. Then he will plunder his house. “

Using our Authority

Isaiah 43:2 “When you pass through waters, I will be with you. And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, nor shall the flame kindle on you. ³ For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior; I gave Egypt for your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba in your place. ⁴ **Since you were precious in My sight, you have been honorable, and I have loved you; therefore, I will give men for you, and people for your life. 5. Do not fear, for I am with you; I will bring your descendants from the east, and gather you from the west; ⁶ I will say to the north, “Give them up,” and to the south, “Do not keep them back. Bring My sons from afar, and My daughters from the ends of the earth, ⁷ even everyone who is called by My name,** for I have created him for My glory; I have formed him, and I have made him.”

The call to recover all

1 Samuel 30:1 “Now when David and his men came to Ziklag on the third day, the Amalekites had raided the south as far as Ziklag. They had struck Ziklag and burned it with fire. ² They had taken as captives all the women who were there. They did not kill anyone, but carried them off and went on their way.

³ David and his men came to the city, and they found it burned with fire, and their wives, their sons, and their daughters taken captive. ⁴ So David and the people that were with him lifted up their voice and wept until they had no strength in them to weep. ⁵ Now David’s two wives were taken captive, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess and Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite. ⁶ David was greatly distressed, for the people talked of stoning

him, because all the people were bitter in spirit, each over his sons and daughters. But David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.

⁷ And David said to Abiathar the priest, the son of Ahimelek, "Please bring the ephod to me." So Abiathar brought the ephod to David. ⁸ David inquired at the LORD, saying, "Should I pursue after this raiding party? Will I overtake them?"

And He answered him, "Pursue *them*, for you will surely overtake them and will surely recover *all*."

⁹ So David went, he and the six hundred men who were with him. And they came to the brook Besor, where those that were left behind remained. ¹⁰ But David pursued, he and four hundred men, for two hundred who were too exhausted to cross over the brook Besor remained behind.

¹¹ They found an Egyptian in the field and took him to David. He gave him bread and he ate, and they made him drink water. ¹² And they gave him a part of a cake of figs and two cakes of raisins. When he had eaten, his spirit came back to him, for he had not eaten bread or drunk any water for three days and nights.

¹³ Then David said to him, "To whom do you belong? And where are you from?"

And he said, "I am a young man of Egypt, servant to an Amalekite. And my master left me, because three days ago I fell sick. ¹⁴ We raided the south of the Kerethites, the south of Judah, and the south of Caleb. And we burned Ziklag with fire." ¹⁵ David said to him, "Will you bring me down to this raiding party?" And he said, "Swear to me by God that you will neither kill me, nor deliver me into the hand of my master, and I will bring you down to this raiding party."

¹⁶ When he brought him down, they were spread out over all the land, eating, drinking, and dancing, because of all the great spoil which they had taken from the land of the Philistines and from the land of Judah. ¹⁷ David struck them from twilight until the evening of the next day, and no man escaped except four hundred young men who rode on camels and fled. ¹⁸ So David recovered all that the Amalekites had taken, and David rescued his two wives. ¹⁹ Now there was nothing missing, from the smallest *thing* to the greatest, neither sons, nor daughters, or plunder, or anything which they had taken. David brought back all *of it*.

God's Pattern: lost loved ones, church harvest/provision

1. Bind the enemy, break his power, and command him to release what is ours
2. Drive out the enemy's influence and destroy his works
3. The Holy Spirit drawing in the people and blowing in the provision
4. The angels are sent unto those that shall inherit salvation
5. Praise God for the victory and believe him
